PLEASE NOTE:

- o Each applicant **MUST** appear in person with a duly completed form (REG.136D from kenyaembassy.com).
- o A money Order/Cashier's Check of US\$ 50 (payable to the Embassy of the Republic of Kenya)
- o Three (03) passport-size photos with these dimensions: 35 mm x 45 mm (3.5 cm x 4.5 cm). Photos **MUST** be taken on a white background.
- o The processing of ID will take approximately 4-6 weeks from the date of application. Therefore, a prepaid, self-addressed United States Postal Service (USPS) Express overnight or Priority Mail with delivery confirmation return envelope **MUST** be submitted with all applications.

KENYA ID ISSUANCE REQUIREMENTS

FIRST-TIME APPLICANTS (AND HOLDERS OF 1ST GENERATION ID)

- o Copy of Birth Certificate of the applicant
- o Copy of valid Kenyan passport of the applicant
- o Copy of Kenya ID and/or Kenya passport of either of the parents
- o The original 1st generation ID (required for holders of 1st generation IDs) **OR**
- o Copy of Certificate of Registration
- o Copy of Naturalization Certificate
- o The original 1st generation ID (required for holders of 1st generation IDs)

REPLACEMENT OF LOST/ DUPLICATE/MUTILATED ID

- o Copy of a police report **OR** a notarized affidavit stating how you lost your ID (lost cases only)
- o Copy of valid Kenyan passport of the applicant
- o Copy of Birth Certificate of the applicant
- o Copy of the applicant's ID (if available)
- o Original ID (for duplicate or mutilated applications)

CHANGE OF PARTICULARS

- o Original ID of applicant
- o Marriage certificate
- o Copies of the couples IDs
- o Please note for married ladies who wish to change their names, both husband and wife **MUST** be present during the application process.
