- 2. Representation and Visibility: Diaspora communities often face challenges in terms of representation and visibility globally. The Jamhuri Diaspora Awards specifically focuses on how the Diaspora can help elevate the visibility of talented individuals and their accomplishments, which can in turn inspire and motivate others within the community. It will send a powerful message that individuals from the Diaspora have the potential to excel in different spheres and make significant contributions to society and be acknowledged by their country.
- 3. Networking and collaboration: This award brings together accomplished individuals from the Diaspora community, providing them with a platform for networking and collaboration. It will facilitate connections between successful individuals in various fields, fostering opportunities for mentorship, partnerships, and knowledge sharing. This can lead to the growth of professional networks and the development of initiatives that benefit the diaspora community and the country as a whole

This Award will be an annual Awards & Gala Ceremony (on the sidelines of the diaspora investment conference) that will celebrate & and immortalize Kenyans in the Diaspora who have achieved milestones & and broken ceilings in the past, present, and future.


The ceremony shall bring together the entire fraternity of Kenyan stakeholders and players in all states and territories. It will be a glamorous Red carpet event that recognizes and celebrates the best of the diaspora. The awards aim to encourage, empower, and motivate those in the Diaspora and Kenya to narrate the Kenyan Story & and to celebrate Uzalendo, the resilience of the Kenyan SPIRIT as we reclaim and preserve our rich and diverse culture.

The winners shall be nominated by the Diaspora communities & tallied through Regional Academies and forwarded to the Secretariat. The Secretariat shall coordinate and forward the final list for recognition by the Head of State.

Every year the Head of State will honor those who have made extraordinary contributions to the Country through their dedication and creativity. The Jamhuri Diaspora Awards are given to the country's non-resident "unsung heroes" who made significant differences demonstrated leadership qualities and espoused the Kenyan spirit outside.







- 02 TALANTA Arts and Culture: Celebrating achievements in various artistic disciplines, including visual arts, performing arts, music, literature, film, fashion, and design.
- O3 KUJITOLEA -Philanthropy and Social Impact: Recognizing individuals who have made significant contributions to social causes, community development, philanthropy, or humanitarian efforts.
- UTAFITI Science, Technology, and innovation: Highlighting achievements in scientific research, technological innovation, technology transfer, advancements in medicine, engineering, computer science, or other scientific disciplines.
- MICHEZO Sports and Athletics: Acknowledging exceptional performances and contributions in sports, including individual athletes, coaches, and teams.



UONGOZI -Leadership and Advocacy: Recognizing individuals who have demonstrated exceptional leadership skills, advocacy for social justice, and human rights, or made significant contributions to public service.

TANGAZA -Media and Journalism: Honoring excellence in journalism, media production, storytelling, or media advocacy that promotes understanding and awareness of diaspora issues

O8 UTETEZI – This Award will acknowledge individuals who have exceptionally championed and fought for the rights of Kenyans in the Diaspora.

D9 ELIMU - Education and Mentorship: Recognizing individuals who have made a significant impact in the field of education, teaching, mentorship, or educational innovation.

10 NYUMBA KUMI -Community Engagement: Recognizing individuals who have demonstrated exceptional community engagement, volunteerism, or grassroots initiatives benefiting the diaspora community.

MAZINGIRA - Environmental Conservation: Celebrating individuals who have contributed to environmental sustainability, conservation efforts, or raising awareness about environmental issues.


**UTAMADUNI** -Cultural Preservation: Honoring individuals who have made significant contributions to preserving and promoting the cultural heritage, traditions, language, or history of the diaspora community.

- 13 UZALENDO This accolade seeks to acknowledge the outstanding contributions made by an individual in supporting, promoting, and exemplifying exemplary patriotism.
- 14 KIJII AWARD This is the Diversity Recognition Award, intended for non-citizens who have outstanding advocated for and contributed to issues concerning Kenya, thereby being recognized as honorary citizens.
- 15 UVUMBUZI- This award will be focused on individuals who identified or explored new opportunities, encompassing but not limited to, the development of new job prospects, initiation of new business ventures, etc.



## How >>

- 1. **PLANNING MAPPING**: The State Department establishes the purpose, goals, and criteria for the awards program. They determine the categories, eligibility requirements, nomination process, judging criteria, and timeline.
- 2. PROMOTION CALL FOR NOMINATIONS: The awards program will be promoted through various channels, such as websites, social media, traditional media, community organizations, and word-of-mouth. The call for nominations will be announced by the Secretariat, inviting individuals to submit nominations for deserving candidates. Apart from the individuals, the awards could also be conferred to an association of people in the Diaspora
- 3. NOMINATION PERIOD: Interested individuals will submit nominations for eligible candidates within the specified timeframe. Nominations will require the completion of nomination forms and, providing supporting documents, or testimonials.
- 4. SCREENING EVALUATION: The Secretariat will review the nominations to ensure they meet the eligibility criteria. The Secretariat shall establish screening committees or panels of judges who will evaluate the nominations based on predetermined criteria and the selection process. This may involve reviewing submitted materials, conducting interviews, or seeking additional references.
- 5. FINALIST SELECTION: The Secretariat through the screening committee or judges will narrow down the nominations to a shortlist of finalists in each category. The number of finalists may vary depending on the program's rules.





- 6. GALA AWARDS EVENT: A formal awards ceremony or event is organized to honor and celebrate the winners. This can include speeches, performances, presentations, and the presentation of awards or trophies.



















# **DIASPORA AWARDS PROCESS**



#### What >>

The national values of Kenya are enshrined in the Kenyan Constitution and reflect the ideals and principles that the country aspires to uphold. The Constitution of Kenya, adopted in 2010, outlines the following national values:

- 1. Patriotism: Kenyans are encouraged to be loyal and devoted to their country, promoting its interests, unity, and progress.
- 2. National Unity: Renyans are expected to foster harmony, cohesion, and a sense of belonging among diverse ethnic, cultural, and religious groups in the country.
- 3. Sharing of Resources and Opportunities: Kenyans are called upon to promote equitable distribution of resources, opportunities, and benefits among all citizens to reduce disparities and enhance inclusivity.
- 4. Democracy and Participation of the People: Kenyans are encouraged to uphold democratic principles, participate in decision-making processes, and respect the rule of law.
- 5. Social Justice: Kenyans are expected to promote fairness, equality, and the protection of fundamental rights and freedoms for all citizens.
- 6. Human Dignity: Kenyans are called upon to respect and uphold the dignity of every individual, recognizing their inherent worth and rights.





- 3. Good Governance: Kenyans are expected to promote transparency, accountability, integrity, and the prudent use of resources in public affairs.
- 9. Sustainable Development: Kenyans are encouraged to pursue economic, social, and environmental sustainability, ensuring the well-being of present and future generations.
- 10. Respect for the Environment: Kenyans are called upon to protect and conserve the environment, recognizing the importance of sustainable resource management and environmental stewardship.

These national values conform with Article 10 of the Kenyan constitution and provide a framework for shaping the country's governance, policies, and societal aspirations, to foster a just, inclusive, and prosperous nation.


